

Newbridge on Usk

## Walking Route

Newbridge on Usk Circular Route

Distance: 3.55 km / 2.21 miles Walking Time: 1 hour Ability: Easy (8 stiles to cross)

- 1. Starting from the Newbridge on Usk, turn left before the bridge and walk uphill on the tarmac lane passing Sumach House on your left.
- 2. After passing Yew Tree Cottage on your left, enter the field ahead through the gate, post marked with a yellow footpath arrow.
- 3. Head straight on, crossing two stiles and enter the field, keeping close to the field edge with the hedgerow to your right.
- 4. Cross the double stile into open field and head straight on towards the stile and tall oak tree, keeping the farm buildings to the far right.
- 5. Cross the bridge and keep the fenced pond to your right. Cross the stile onto the tarmac driveway.

- 6. Turn left, and follow tarmac driveway away from the farm buildings, walking gently uphill passing ponds to your left and right.
- 7. After passing through farm gates travel downhill from the small rise. Ignore stiles to the left and right and follow the driveway through a metal gate and onward to a public road.
- 8. After passing the gate to Wern Farm turn left onto the public road, heading uphill passing Coed y Fan bungalow on your left.
- 9. At the road junction keep left, sign posted Tredunnoch and follow the public road passing a village road sign to your left.

- 10. After passing Ton Farm on the left, enter the church yard of St. Andrew, turning left through the memorial lynchgate opposite the village well.
- 11. After passing through white metal gates keep the church to your left and cross the stone stile, located ahead and slightly to the right.
- 12. Keep straight ahead crossing the wooden stile and into the field, keeping straight ahead with the hedgerow to your left.
- 13. Keeping the hedgerow on your left follow the field boundary downhill to a wooden stile, passing Yew Tree Cottage on your left. Cross the stile in the bottom left hand corner of the field and continue down bank steps turning right to follow the tarmac lane back to the Newbridge on Usk.
